Entry Conditions

By entering your script you are agreeing to the following:

1. Closing date is 30 May, 2015 at 4pm.
2. Limit of one entry per person and the running time must be 10 mins or less. Scripts clearly longer than this, will not be accepted.
3. The student entering the competition must be the author of the play submitted.
4. Entrants must be currently living in Queensland, completing secondary education and between the ages of 12-18 yrs.
5. Email both script and this entry form direct to: drobi34@eq.edu.au and a confirmation reply will be sent.
6. Late entries will NOT be accepted.
7. Entries should be inspired by the competition theme for 2015.
8. As the writer, you automatically give your permission to the organizers to present the play at Spotlight.
9. Should my play/theatre work be selected for Spotlight I understand I will receive no royalties for those performances but will be eligible for prizes.
10. Entries submitted must be original and unpublished at the time of entry.
11. Entries are confidential and CANNOT be marked with writer's name or initials.
12. First and subsequent pages must show the title of the play at the head of each page.
13. All pages must be numbered.
14. Entries must be typed in black, Arial 12pt, 1.5 line spaced on an A4 page.
15. If my play is selected/performed, I give Spotlight the right to film/record/photograph it for publicity purposes and uploading in the Learning Place or other public video forum.
16. Once selected for production I may not withdraw my playscript from production for any reason.
17. I understand that in order to have my play/theatre work produced at Spotlight my script may need to be altered by the actors and director producing my play.
18. The judge's decision is final; no correspondence will be entered into.
19. Winners will be notified by phone or email in by June 30.
